

## Dress Code and Guidelines for Mason Co-Op

In keeping with the values of purity and integrity that the Mason Homeschool Co-Operative holds at heart, we have developed a Dress Code and guidelines for every family. Our desire is to set forth a Godly example of purity and integrity.

- No spaghetti straps, low cut tops, bare midriffs (even while bending or stretching), no sheer materials, or short shorts
- No tight shirts or shorts
- No clothing with words on the back of shorts, sweats, or pants
- No clothing with inappropriate messages, slogans, or pictures
- No cell phones, CD players, gameboys, MP3 players, etc are to be used at any time during classes or opening assembly.
- No form of tobacco, alcohol, or drugs
- Young Men: NO hats of any form in the building.
- No knives of any form (pocket or otherwise) unless specifically in use for meals.

By signing this statement, we understand and agree to abide by the Mason Homeschool Co-Op Dress Code and Guidelines while at any sponsored event. In the event that this agreement is not followed, the Board will take appropriate action. The student will be required to put on a sweater. Electronics may be taken away for the day if used improperly and returned to the parent at the end of the day. This will always be done after discussion with and through the attending parent so as to preserve all dignity and respect. The only exception to this is that any teacher is asked to take any electronic items that are being used during class and bring it to the parent.
