

Class title: Problem Solving

Description of course: In this class we will focus on decision-making and problem solving from a biblical and practical perspective. The class will work on group and individual projects, weaving biblical wisdom into practical decision-making.

Examples of projects: determining living expenses and setting a budget based on a given annual wage; journaling (and alternatives) to aid in problem solving; how to know what God wants you to do; where to get good advice; how to evaluate sources of information; and more.

At this point the materials are being developed. A student can expect that this class will involve a small amount of preparation outside of class and possibly group projects that may require a few meetings outside of class time. (This will be up to the parents.)
